- Develop and implement a multi-year training program with the clear objective of qualifying at least one athlete for the 2028 Olympic Games in Los Angeles.
- Establish a structured athlete development pathway from talent identification through to elite performance, including annual milestones and performance indicators.
- Plan, coordinate, and support national team competition participation, including preparation, on-site coaching, and post-event analysis.
- Lead the Western Training Group, including the planning and delivery of approximately five training sessions per week (strength, technical skills, tactics, and BMX-specific training loads), as well as all related preparation and follow-up activities.
- Conduct systematic talent identification at regional and local BMX training sessions and competitions, while collaborating with clubs, schools, and multi-sport development structures to identify promising young athletes.
